

Student Participation Agreement

This document contains the approved EXAELIA Academy Student Participation Agreement, defining the rights and obligations of participating students.

Student Participation Agreement

This agreement defines the rights and obligations of students participating in the EXAELIA Academy during its first implementation period. Participation in the EXAELIA Academy is voluntary and complements the students' formal academic studies.

Participation Scope

The EXAELIA Academy provides a collaborative environment for knowledge exchange, mentoring, and interaction with academia and industry experts. Participation in the EXAELIA Academy does not replace, interfere with, or modify the formal academic supervision provided by the student's home institution.

Rights of Participants

Participants have the right to:

- *Take part in EXAELIA Academy activities related to their selected topic, including webinars and workshops.*
- *Receive mentoring, guidance, and constructive feedback from designated EXAELIA mentors.*
- *Present their work in a supportive, non-evaluative environment.*
- *Retain full ownership of their academic work, including thesis content, data, and results.*
- *Be acknowledged as EXAELIA Academy participants in communication and dissemination activities, subject to their consent.*
- *Receive a certificate of participation upon successful completion of the EXAELIA Academy cycle.*

Obligations of Participants

Participants are expected to:

- *Actively engage in EXAELIA Academy activities during its first Academy implementation period, according to their availability and academic schedule.*
- *Prepare and present their work during scheduled Academy webinars when requested.*
- *Engage constructively and respectfully with mentors and fellow participants.*
- *Respect confidentiality when project-related or partner-sensitive information is shared.*
- *Inform the Academy Committee in case of withdrawal or prolonged unavailability.*

Confidentiality and Webinar Recordings

Academy webinars and workshops are considered internal project activities unless explicitly stated otherwise. Webinars may be recorded for internal use. Any external sharing of recordings or presentation material requires the explicit consent of the participants involved.

Data Protection

Participants acknowledge that their personal data will be processed solely for the purposes of organizing and managing the EXAELIA Academy, in accordance with applicable data protection regulations.

Withdrawal

Participants may withdraw from the EXAELIA Academy at any time by informing the Academy Committee. Withdrawal does not require justification but may affect eligibility for receiving a certificate of participation.

Certification

Certificates of participation will be issued by the EXAELIA Project Coordinator in collaboration with EASN-TIS to students who demonstrate active engagement throughout the Academy cycle.
